### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Entries may be fiction (short story) or non-fiction (essay or article).
- Entries are encouraged across a broad spectrum of writing, including, but not limited to, the following categories: contemporary, historical, the natural world, memoir, whimsy, humour and literary.
- Not more than 3,000 words.
- Maximum two entries per person.
- Entry fee of \$20.00 per title entered. Cheques/money orders should be made payable to Forty Degrees South Pty Ltd.
- Authors may download a style guide from the 40°South website.
- Entrants must assert that entries are their own original work and that the entries have not been previously published.
- Each entry must be provided as hard copy and as an electronic file.
- Authors must provide full contact details as well as a brief CV and a photo to be used if the entry is included in the anthology.
- The winning entry will receive a cash prize of **\$500.00** and prominent publication in *TASMANIA 40°South*.
- The winner will be announced in the Autumn 2012 Issue of *TASMANIA 40°South*.
- At the discretion of the judges two runners-up may each receive \$100.00.
- A selection of the best entries will be published in an anthology in 2012.
